Meursault grapes come from the Vireuils plot planted in the highslopes of the hills. Its limestone terroir is a perfect fit for Chardonnay. This full bodied wine is generous in aromas of white flowers, peaches and toast. The finish is long and reveals flavors of oak and honey with a creamy texture on the palate.
