Alfred Gratien Brut Non-Vintage. Predominantly Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier, with a smaller amount of Pinot Noir, all sourced from Grand and Premier Cru sites around Epernay. This blend is fermented and aged in French oak with extra time on the lees to enhance its toasty character. The overall profile is lively, rounded, and textured, with minerality, savoury depth, and a long finish.
