Made from the Charmat Method, this is a dry but still vibrant and fresh Prosecco offering enticing aromas of ripe orchard apple and pear with hints of zesty lemon. Straw yellow in color, the palate delivers a luscious sweet peach with more apple to follow, balanced with crisp acidity and a clean finish.
