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TASTING NOTES

Michel Magnien Gevrey Chambertin Aux Echezeaux 2018. Deep in an elegant ruby colour, this Pinot Noir has a very fragrant nose with cassis and blackberry, followed by rose. The palate is bold, powerful and concentrated. Expect notes of black fruit with hints of licorice and leather, followed by an ending of olive. The core has ripe tannins, while acidity keeps the wine fresh despite its weight.
