TASTING NOTES

Bolney Wine Estate Classic Cuvée. This is a stylish, traditional method, Cuvée. Expect notes of delightful hedgerow fruits and brioche notes combined with ripe apple and stone fruits. This sparkling Cuvée is fresh and elegant with persistent mousse. With the southern English Maritime influence of sunnier summers and cooling sea breezes, this leads to slower ripening and retention to natural acidity, crucial for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes that are in this vintage.
