

TASTING NOTES

This cuvée incorporates the thematic "Material". A series of wines aged for 12 months in the cellar for which we have chosen to claim the container through the material of the labels. For our ROUGE BETON cuvée, we chose the concrete relief aspect of the ovoid vats used. A red wine with ruby highlights, expressive nose, complex, long and fresh in the mouth, the tannins are fine and melted.
