

Blanc Plume Rouge Beton 2019. A vibrant red, the nose is expressive and complex, while the palate is long and fresh, with a harmonious balance and fine, well-integrated tannins that provide a smooth, elegant texture and a persistent finish. Vinification and maturation take place over 12 months in 7-hectoliter concrete, a process that enhances purity, freshness, and complexity in the wine.
