TASTING NOTES

Chateau de Chamirey Mercurey Blanc 2020. This vintage opens with a bright palate of citrus, stone fruit and lovely florals with a hint of a woody tone and acidity. On the nose, expect to pick up vanilla and oak, followed by peach and pear. This wine comes from the Mercurey appellation of Burgundy's Cote Chalonnaise, that balances a white traditional Burgundian wine.
