Savagnin is an aromatic grape, also called "the white traminer", which means : aromatic richness, high natural level of acidity. That explains why this wine expresses such an aromatic richness, with aromas of citrus (grapefruit), green pineapple and exotic fruits and a light touch of white pepper and lilac
