Losada Vinos de Finca Mencia 2019. The 2019 Losada from Bierzo is an expressive MencÃ-a-based wine that captures the essence of its clay hillside vineyards. Crafted from 99% MencÃ-a and 1% Dona Blanca, the wine offers deep aromas of black cherry and plum, layered with hints of dark chocolate, licorice, and subtle toast. Mineral undertones and mountain herbs add complexity, while fine tannins and vibrant acidity provide structure and elegance. Aged for 12 months in partially used French oak barrels, it delivers a harmonious balance of fruit, freshness, and delicate oak influence.
