Stift Goettweig Ried Gottschelle Gruner Veltliner 2021. The grapes of this Gruner Veltliner come from 50-70 years old vines which reflects in the complexity of it's characteristics. Fruity and fresh, with notes of ripe apple, banana and honeydew melon. The fruity aromas continue on the palate, along with fresh acidity and the typical Veltliner white pepper note. A full round and creamy Veltliner with a long finish

Gruner Veltliner

Gruner Veltliner is a white grape variety that is very much an Austrian speciality. Planted on more than a third of Austria's vineyards, it ripens late and produces characteristic, perfumed wines of substance, with zesty citrus, crisp green fruit and a hallmark white pepper spice on the finish.

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
