Pascal Bouchard Bourgogne Chardonnay 2019. This organic, fresh and crisp Chardonnay is grown in Burgundy, and is aged for 8 to 12 months in mainly stainless steel, with 20% of the grapes going into French oak. The palate has a velvety texture with a balance of minerality with notes of stone fruits and subtle vanilla.
