Jean-Marie Haag Riesling Grand Cru Zinnkoepfle 2020. This vintage is bright and zinging with energy. There is a core of taut minerality, allied to a lime zest and grapefruit buzz. Still youthful, it is starting to develop some spice and herb complexity. The uppish citrus acidity ensures this one will evolve gracefully and slowly.
