TASTING NOTES

Six Poets Cabernet Sauvignon. This red opens with aromas of blackcurrant, cedar, and crushed violets. With benefits from the region's exceptionally low rainfall and the cooling influence of the Pacific Ocean. On the palate, it offers a confident structure, with dark cherry and plum notes layered in finely textured tannins. Subtle notes of cocoa and toasted oak lend depth without overpowering, leading to a smooth, lingering finish that balances richness.
