TASTING NOTES

Gerard Seguin Gevrey Chambertin Vieilles Vignes 2022. The 2022 season brought warmth and generous sunshine, resulting in healthy grapes and excellent ripeness. Despite the heat, careful vineyard management maintained balance and vibrancy. This vintage delivers a powerful yet polished expression of Pinot Noir, with a rich notes of ripe blackberries, cherries, and exotic spice. The palate is dense and silky, offering depth and complexity with a persistent finish. Vinification remained traditional: manual harvest, cold maceration, indigenous yeast fermentation, and 15 days of vatting. Ageing lasted 12 to 18 months in barrels, 30% new oak,

lending subtle toast and finesse.
