Chateau Simon Sauternes 2019. A traditional blend of Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc, and Muscadelle botrytised grapes are pressed and aged in French oak barrels to age for 18 months. This full bottle (750ml) from the 2019 vintage offers tropical fruit flavours of dried mango, caramelised pineapple and candied orange.
