Chateau d'Astros Absolu Provence Rose 2023. Made from old-vine Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre on high-altitude, chalky-limestone soils, this rose is balanced and complex, offering notes of lemon and strawberry, with a refreshing minerality on the palate. On the nose, expect notes of white peach and exotic fruit.
