Chateau d'Astros Absolu Provence Rose 2023. Made from old-vine Grenache, Syrah, and Mourv  dre grown on high-altitude chalky-limestone soils, and aged in stainless steel vats. Absolu is balanced and complex, offering notes of lemon and strawberry with a refreshing minerality that lingers on the palate.
