Tiefenbrunner Turmhof Blauburgunder Pinot Noir 2022. This Pinot Noir comes from vineyards as high as 980 metres in altitude, on a gravel and clay soil. The vintage is aged for 8 months in oak barrels, with subtle ageing done in stainless steel. The 2022 features a subtle bouquet of blackberries, raspberries and cherries. It has a youthful strength while being elegant and full-bodied.
