TASTING NOTES

Champagne Pommery Apanage Blanc de Noirs. This is a prestige
Champagne crafted from 100% Grand Cru grapes, primarily Pinot Noir
(70%) with Meunier (30%). It is aged on the lees for 4 years and disgorged
in January 2023, it reflects Pommery's dedication to elegance and
structure. The wine is full-bodied and balanced, with floral and honeyed
nuances, layered with subtle spice and red fruit complexity.
