TASTING NOTES

Jean-Marie Haag Gewurztraminer Grand Cru Zinnkoepfle 2020. Pure and elegant, this wine is well structured and refined with an elegant finish that reflects the Grand Cru origins. The nose is fine and complex, revealing floral notes of white blossoms alongside hints of strawberry and mint with a subtle mineral undertone that reflects its sandy and limestone terroir. On the palate, the aromas are confirmed with depth and precision, offering sustained flavors and a delicate freshness.
