Domaine Jean-Francois Merieau Coeur de Roche Sauvignon Blanc 2020. From vines planted over fifty years ago, this wine is fermented in oak barrels and aged on its lees in Merieau's impressive chalk cellars. The result is a powerful expression of the varietal, marked by intensity and richness across the palate. Its generous volume, beautifully balanced acidity, and remarkable length suggest excellent potential for continued ageing and increased complexity over time.
