TASTING NOTES Alfred Gratien Blanc de Blancs 2017. Harvested entirely from Grand Cru vineyards in the Côte des Blancs region near Épernay, this 100% Chardonnay expression showcases why the chalk-rich terroirs of Champagne define high-end sparkling whites. The Chardonnay grapes bring vibrant citrus and green apple freshness, reinforced by a pure mineral backbone shaped by the cool continental climate, which is perfect for crisp acidity and longevity. Subtle notes of brioche and almond emerge from extended lees aging, adding textural depth and a creamy mid-palate while preserving that characteristic brightness. The result is a refined, age-worthy
