TASTING NOTES

Pascal Bouchard Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2022. This is a textbook Pinot Noir from Burgundy, that displays a very fruit forward nose showcasing strawberry and plum with a hint of spice. On the palate, there is subtle tannins that provide elegance and tones of earthy dark fruit, and a dash of smoke, given that 20 to 30% of the grapes going through French oak ageing for 8 to 12 months.
