Argento Altamira Single Vineyard Malbec 2021 Organic. From high-altitude vineyards in Altamira, this single-vineyard Malbec is fermented in stainless steel and aged in French oak for added depth. Intense aromas of blackberry, blueberry, and floral notes combine with subtle spice and mineral hints. The palate is concentrated yet refined, with firm tannins and a persistent finish.
