It greets with a delicate ruby color and an aromatic bouquet of cherry, raspberry, blackcurrant leaf, and herbal spice. On the palate, it's rich and full-bodied, with sweet, polished tannins, vivid cassis notes, and a finish that blends fruit, leafiness, and savory tannic structure. A vibrant, terroir-driven Cabernet Franc that balances ripeness with freshness.
