

Goleta Merlot Non-Vintage. From Chile's Central Valley, the warmer days and cooler nights make this a classic expression of Merlot, showcasing a medium-bodied wine with subtle tannins. Expect aromas of red currant, green peppers, dark plums, and a hint of smoke. On the palate, the notes of plum and red currant continue through to the finish, leaving a smooth aftertaste that makes this a true expression of Chilean red wines.
