## TASTING NOTES

Chateau d'Astros Augustine Provence Rose Magnum 2023. This magnum rose combines aromas brim with exotic lychee and rose petals, red berries, and lime zest, rounded by a tropical fruit profile. On the palate, expect red cranberry and berry flavours to be portrayed, alongside freshness of lime and a pinch of honey, elevated by subtle tannins that provide refined structure.
