### TASTING NOTES

Maison Sabadie Reserve Blanc 2023. A fresh and aromatic white wine crafted using skin maceration to enhance structure and complexity. Fermented at low temperatures under strict control and gently pressed with pneumatic systems, it preserves vibrant fruit character. The nose offers ripe white fruit with hints of grapefruit and pineapple, while the palate is lively and long, marked by abundant freshness.
