Roche Costamagna Riserva Barolo Rocche dell'Annunziata 2019. Made from 100% Nebbiolo exclusively from one of the most historial vineyards in Roche'dell'Annunziata, this vintage is elegant and full bodied, showcasing aromas of roses and small red berries followed by a elegant palate with sweet tannins. This vintage went through a maceration period for around 3 weeks, and then aged gracefully for 18 months in large oak barrels.
