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## TASTING NOTES

Derame Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie 2022. This energised Muscadet has a light body and fresh flavours of green apple, citrus fruit alongside crisp acidity and a saline fish. The wine is aged for 6 months in stainless steel and spends that time on lees which adds a gentle roundness and extra dimension to the wine.
