TASTING NOTES

Beau Charmois Pinot Noir 2024. This Pinot from Languedoc shows bright aromas of cherry, raspberry, and wild strawberry, with subtle floral notes and a hint of spice. The palate is light to medium-bodied, with silky tannins, fresh acidity, and a smooth finish. Vinification includes stainless steel fermentation at controlled temperatures, short maceration for gentle extraction, and brief maturation with a touch of French oak for complexity.
