






SIGNATURE PINOTAGE



TASTING NOTES

Spier Signature Pinotage 2021. Sourced from warm Western Cape vineyards on Spier's historic estate in Stellenbosch, the 2021 vintage is a bold and expressive reflection of its environment. Grapes were harvested, and crushed into stainless steel tanks for fermentation, followed by 20% of the grapes aged in French oak barrels with the other 80% in stainless steel for 8-10 months. The palate is plush and medium-bodied, highlighted by earthy, slightly smoky notes and soft, silky tannins. Finishing smooth and medium-dry with balanced acidity, this Pinotage hits between approachability and structured sophistication.
