TASTING NOTES

Spier Frans K Smit White Blend 2018. With the maritime influences enhancing both vineyards for this creation, this blend combines Sémillon from the Helderberg's dry and rich soils with Sauvignon Blanc from the Tygerberg's cooler southern slopes. The wine displays a glossy straw hue and opens with generous aromas of tropical and citrus notes, such as pineapple, lime, and elderflower, that are interwoven with smoke and vanilla. On the palate, it is creamy and concentrated yet lifted by acidity and biscuity texture due to lees ageing.
