





GOOD NATURED ORGANIC CHENIN BLANC



TASTING NOTES

Spier Good Natured Chenin Blanc 2024. Nestled in Stellenbosch's clay and granite soils, this wine thrives under holistic, regenerative farming. In the glass, the aromatic wine presents a pale gold hue, leading into notes of citrus peel and lemon zest, followed by ripe stone fruits, such as peach. Subtle tropical notes of litchi and pineapple play a role, while a refined minerality grounds the fruit flavours. The palate feels juicy and vibrant, finishing with a zesty lift that feels both fresh and rounded. Elegant and balanced, this Chenin Blanc reveals a mid-weight body with bright acidity that frames the fruit, making it both accessible now and suitable for short

to medium aging.
