TASTING NOTES

Schloss Johannisberg Prince Metternich Rheingau Riesling 2023. This is the first estate release in 10 years and is 100% Riesling looking to epitomise a 'Rheingau Riesling-RR' meaning dry but well-balanced, light and juicy, charming and finessed with a good amount of intensity and grip. The terroir is quartzite, slate and clay soils from steep slopes and fermentation takes place in temperature controlled stainless steel vats.
