TASTING NOTES

Les Vins Alphonse Mellot La Moussiere Rouge 2022. A refined Pinot Noir from vines aged 5â€"45 years, hand-harvested and sorted before cold maceration for 5 -10 days and fermentation in wooden vats to preserve varietal character. After gentle pressing, the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation and ages on fine lees for 10-18 months in barrels, 80 -100% of which are new oak. This careful process delivers an elegant, well-structured wine.
