Dom Perignon 2013. This is an exquisite and greatly balanced Champagne made from a blend of 51% Pinot Noir and 49% Chardonnay, with aromas of floral, citrus, toasted vanilla and coffee. On the palate, expect to taste pear and lemons followed by toasted honey and almonds with a silky mouth feel.
