Jean Jacques Girard Beaune Premier Cru Clos du Roi 2017. This is a highly expressive Beaune Premier Cru, with aromas of dark and sour cherries, blueberry, and herbaceous spice, followed by nutmeg. On the palate, expected a structured body full of black cherry and firm velvety tannins. Perfect to age for 10-15 years.
