TASTING NOTES

Domaine de Bellene Cote de Nuits Villages Vielles Vignes 2020. This is a bright medium-bodied Pinot Noir expressing ripe red cherry and raspberry with a bouquet of violet and earth-spice. The palate is balanced, lively and supple with elegant tannins and a persistent finish. Oak is present but subtle, allowing purity of fruit and terroir to shine.
