Argento Organic Fairtrade Rose 2024. Harvested from organic Malbec vines in Alto Agrelo, where summer temperatures swing from 35°C midday to 10-15°C overnight. This fairtrade rosé captures that fresh-altitude signature. The 2024 vintage exhibits a bright pink tint and presents an expressive nose of red berries and floral notes. The palate is crisp, with refreshing acidity and a clean, lively finish, ideal for warm afternoons. It is a light-bodied, organic, and socially conscious rosé with bright freshness and pure varietal character.
