



Bodegas Obergo Caramelos de Obergo Red 2023. This intense ruby red is Garnacha dominant with a touch of Merlot and has been aged for 4 months in French and American oak. Given being grown on vineyards with a 650 metre altitude, this helps give this robust red shows aromas and flavours of strawberries and violets underpinned by mineral notes on an otherwise long rounded finish.
