TASTING NOTES

Alain Chavy Puligny Montrachet Les 8 Climats 2022. This expressive Burgundian Chardonnay showcases the essence of Puligny terroir. The nose reveals stone fruits, with subtle hints of honey. On the palate, it is fresh and mineral, yet rich and rounded, offering sharp acidity and a long, refreshing finish. Crafted from eight distinct plots, vinified with minimal intervention, and aged in a mix of 228-litre and 400-litre barrels, this wine achieves perfect balance and depth. Best opened 30 minutes before serving to allow full aromatic expression.
