Vincent Latour Mersault Les Grands Charrons 2022. From prime Meursault vines aged 25â€"60 years, this is a dense and rich, yet fresh and elegant white wine. The nose is elegant, with fine floral notes and a delicate touch of vanilla. The palate is balanced by freshness and a lingering elegance. Vinification includes gentle pressing), and ageing on fine lees for 12 months followed by 4â€"6 months in tank, without bâtonnage, ensuring purity and precision.
