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TASTING NOTES

Françoise André Choeur Les Beaune Tue Boeuf 2021. This Pinot Noir is made from grapes hand harvested from 45 year old vines on clay rich soils in Choeur lès Beaune. The nose brings fresh red cherries and subtle raspberry, while the palate is light with silky tannins, fresh acidity and filled with cherry and peach fruit finishing with a hint of spice.
