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TASTING NOTES

Françoise Andre Pommard Vaumeriens Bas 2019. From clay-limestone slopes of Pommard, the vines average around 55 years. Deep ruby in colour, this fragrant red has delicate aromas of rose petal, ripe cherry and plums and a hint of smoky earth. On the palate, expect a concentrated Pinot Noir with fine-grained tannins, lush fruit and a long, savory finish.
