### TASTING NOTES

Cintra Rube Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2023. Made exclusively from Montepulciano grapes, this wine begins fermentation in stainless steel tanks before a brief maturation in oak, adding depth and aromatic complexity. The nose offers vibrant violet and ripe stone fruit, while the palate is harmonious and well-structured, with excellent balance and potential for medium to long-term ageing. A long, persistent finish leaves a refined impression.
