Chateau d'Arcole Saint Emilion Grand Cru 2021. Being aged in oak for 12 to 18 months, expect a lively and rich nose with intense aromas of black cherry and black currant, followed by cedar. On the palate, it is silky with ripe tannins and excellent length. This is an exceptionally impressive St Emilion from a truly great vineyard.
