Pech Sirech Cahors 2021. Deep, lively, and red in colour. The nose is balanced between ripe red fruits and fresh black fruits. On the palate, juicy dark cherries, blackberries, pepper and some sweet spice lead to an appealing and surprisingly fresh finish. Biodynamically farmed, and situated in preserved environment, the wines of Pech Sirech are outstanding examples of the mineral and fine expression Malbec can give.
