TASTING NOTES

Pech Sirech Cahors 2021. A deep, garnet-red wine that reflects the elegance of Cahors' highest terroirs. The nose is expressive with ripe black fruit, hints of violet, and subtle mineral notes. On the palate, it is full-bodied yet refined, with silky tannins, vibrant freshness, and a long, persistent finish marked by precision and depth. Crafted from hand-harvested grapes grown on white clay and Kimmeridgian limestone soils, vinified parcel by parcel under strict biodynamic principles, this wine combines richness with remarkable finesse.
